This coming Friday we are heading down to Balranald Central School to join in their International Day Activities and will finish the day playing sport.

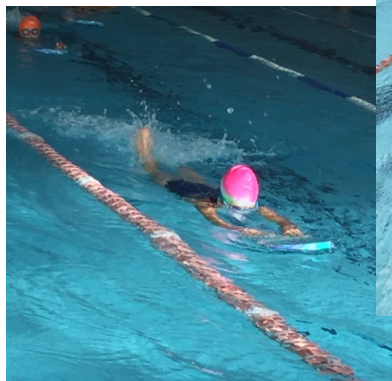
