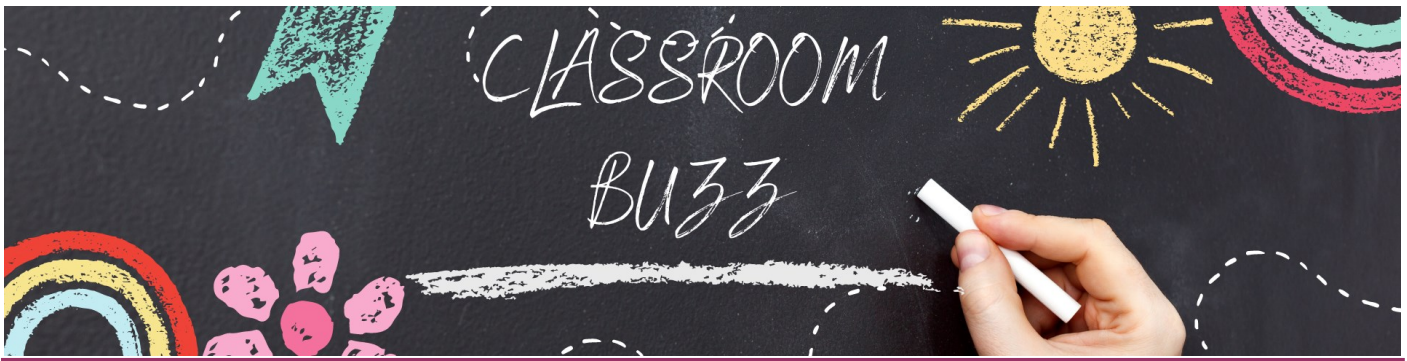
Prize categories were:
